



## **2020-21 Grant Awards**

### **RTSD AWARDS**

#### **Technology Supporting Hybrid Learning – RTSD, Scott Hand Grant Award: \$66,000**

Funding supports purchase of additional monitors where needed and Surface-PRO docking stations for all teachers to support equity and access across the five buildings and supports all teachers in facilitating remote instruction.

#### **Virtual/Hybrid Learning Programs– RTSD, Shawn Dutkiewicz Grant Award: \$12,000**

Funding supports virtual experiences for students that provide opportunities to extend and enrich grade level standards, curriculum, and content including virtual field trips and virtual assembly programs.

### **ELEMENTARY AWARDS**

#### **School Supplies – WES, Gretchen Gerrow Grant Award: \$2,500**

Funding supports school supplies for our financially disadvantaged students by beginning the school year knowing they have all the school supplies they need for a successful year.

#### **Equity and Inclusion in STEM – WES, Sue Dahlstrom Grant Award: \$900**

Funding supports purchase of titles for the Wayne Elementary School library with an emphasis on books by and about women and people of color in the sciences.

### **MIDDLE SCHOOL**

#### **Girls Lead – RMS, Mojdeh Keykhah Grant Award: \$5,000**

In partnership with the **Women's Resource Center** this longstanding program focuses on developing positive decision making skills and enhancing the interests, abilities and character of middle school girls, resulting in increased self-esteem.

#### **3D Printer – RMS, Chris Kelly Grant Award: \$1,999**

Funding supports purchase of a 3D printer to help with development and implementation of curriculum changes due to new staff and Covid-19 school environment.

**QuaranTeen – RMS, Jodi Sabra**

**Grant Award: \$5,500**

Funding supports creation of a music video that captures the real life experience of students during Covid. Workshops include scriptwriting, music, and videography.

**Library Flexible Seating – RMS, Catherine Horan**

**Grant Award: \$5,000**

Funding supports purchase of new seating to allow for collaboration and small group learning.

**COMMUNITY AWARDS**

**RCSE Speaker Series – Radnor Committee for Special Education, Cathy Mair**

**Grant Award: \$3,500**

Funding supports a four-part series providing parents, educators, support staff and various community stakeholders the best practices for inclusive education and how to effectively implement them virtually.

**Total grants awarded in 2020-21: \$90,399**
